



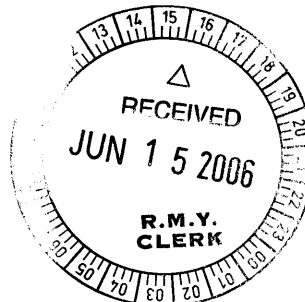

Dear Denis.

It was good to be able to discuss our needs with you over the phone. As per your instructions I will address our concerns and give you a little background in this written request.

The Salvation Army Correctional & Justice Services works mainly with people who have come in conflict with the law for one reason or another. Often people are arrested and taken to the courthouse in Newmarket and after appearing before a Judge they can be released on bail or released with no charges.

This is often the time when a need might arise. They are usually left stranded in Newmarket after their court appearance with no way of getting back to Toronto and often with no funds. What The Salvation Army does, either through our Chaplains or the police services, is give these people a voucher to take to Go Transit. Through an agreement we have with Go Transit they will take the voucher and allow these people to travel to Toronto. At the end of every month Go transit will invoice our office for the charges incurred. The number of people that we need to help varies. One month might be as low as four (4) and the next month might be as high as fifteen (15), but it seems we average around Ten (10).

The reason for us exploring Viva is so that our clients can have another source to travel plus another time frame in which to catch a ride to the city of Toronto.

I am enclosing a copy of the voucher we supply to our clients for your perusal and consideration.

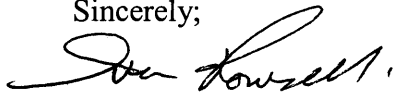
