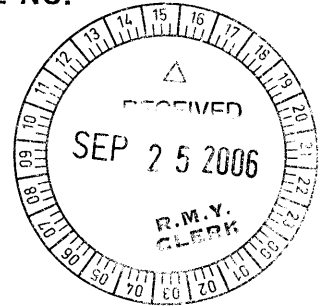

Re: High Street, Sutton – Speed Limit

I am writing with regard to recommendations made at the June 15, 2006 Georgina Accessibility Advisory Committee meeting in which there was much discussion regarding safety issues, for pedestrians with disabilities, while maneuvering on High Street, Sutton.

As you may be aware there are three sets of signal lights affecting pedestrian traffic; at Dalton Road, Middle Street and Highway 48. While there may not be data to support the addition of further signal lights to 'calm traffic flow', there are multiple safety hazards for individuals with disabilities as they try to maneuver High Street. Of specific concern is the speed with which vehicular traffic flows at the Black River Bridge on High Street, out of the sight line of pedestrians on either side of the curve.

It is the GAAC's recommendation to the Region of York Transportation and Works Department that the speed limit along High Street, from Dalton Road to Highway 48, be reduced from 50 KPH to 40 KPH.
