



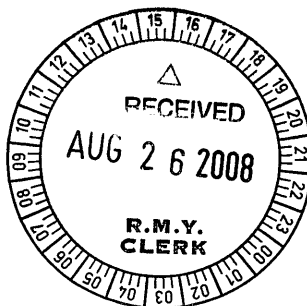

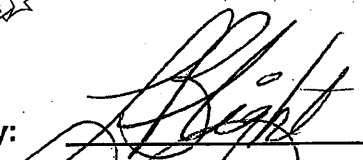

RESOLUTION R11-2008

WHEREAS the Council of the Town of Newmarket has established a Transportation Demand Management Committee (TDM Committee) to address community concerns respecting traffic flow, community lifestyle and environmental health;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Town of Newmarket supports International Car Free Day and Car Free Day Canada on September 22nd, 2008 to complement the efforts of the TDM Committee;

AND WHEREAS the TDM Committee supports alternate transportation options which have the effect of reducing traffic congestion, air pollution and improving community health through supporting and implementing the Smart Commute initiative;

AND WHEREAS Town of Newmarket employees participating in the Smart Commute Newmarket program have logged over 27,500 kms since May 2006, thereby removing over 13.7 tonnes of CO₂ from the atmosphere by walking, cycling, rollerblading, carpooling or taking transit to and from work;

AND WHEREAS raising awareness, promoting changes in commuting behaviour, and involving the public and business owners are key to the sustainability of the urban transportation system, quality of urban life, and urban and natural environments;

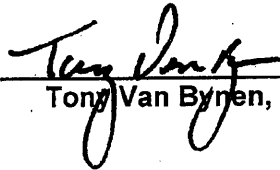
AND WHEREAS by supporting Car Free Day on September 22nd, 2008, the Council of the Town of Newmarket is demonstrating its commitment to the community and support of the initiatives of the TDM Committee;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Town of Newmarket as follows:

THAT the Council of the Town of Newmarket proclaim September 22, 2008 as "Car Free Day" in the Town of Newmarket as an investment into the transportation system, natural environment and quality of life in the Town of Newmarket, Ontario, Canada;
