Re: Town of East Gwillimbury Council Resolution C2007-325CAO

For your information and records, at its regular meeting held on August 13, 2007, the Municipal Council of the Town of East Gwillimbury enacted Resolution C2007-325CAO as follows:

“WHEREAS Council passed resolution C2006-409CPI at its meeting of November 20, 2006 requesting the Region proceed with the environmental assessment process for the widening and urbanization of the Second Concession from Greenlane to Queensville Sideroad; and

WHEREAS since November 2006 the Town and Region have been updating their respective master servicing plans for water, wastewater and transportation of which, the Town's MSPs should be completed by the end of 2007; and

WHEREAS the environmental assessment for the extension of the YDSS along its' proposed alignment within the existing Second Concession right-of-way is nearing completion and will be deposited for approval with the MOE; and

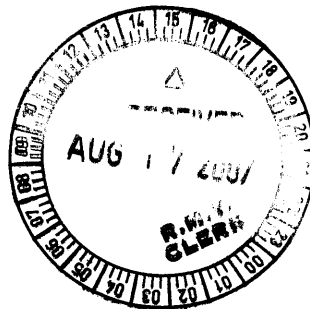
WHEREAS it would be preferable to construct all of the proposed Regional and Town infrastructure within the Second Concession right-of-way at one time to avoid reconstruction of the Second Concession over numerous projects.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT upon approval of the YDSS environment assessment for the extension along the Second Concession right-of-way, the Region proceed immediately with the environmental assessment for the widening and urbanization of the Second Concession from Greenlane to Queensville Sideroad; and

THAT to avoid future disruption, proposed Regional/Town infrastructure identified within the respective MSPs for water and/or wastewater which are to be constructed within the Second Concession right-of-way be pre-serviced wherever possible during the construction of the YDSS project; and

THAT a copy of this resolution be forwarded to the Regional Clerk to provide a formal response to the Town of East Gwillimbury.”

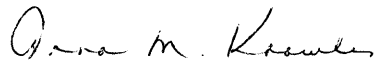
