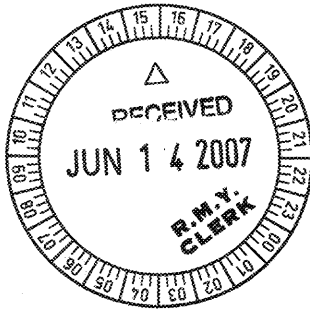

Enclosed you will find a number of signatures petitioning for the reduction of truck traffic on Aurora Rd. east of Hwy.404. Many more signatures could be obtained if I continued to canvas the area. If need be, I will do so.

Over the past few years the number of trucks using Aurora Rd. has grown exponentially. Signage by the region indicates trucks are to use Davis or Bloomington. However through traffic trucks are using Aurora Rd so much that one would think it is an industrial truck route.

We have no objection to the local truck traffic, but as it is a rural residential area we would like through truck traffic diverted to the signed routes. Alternately, if the trucks are allowed to make it a commercial throughway, then we would like the area rezoned.

All who signed want to respect the agricultural/rural/residential zoning and honour the moraine. We would like the support of the Municipality in this by ensuring that the road use corresponds with land use.
