Pursuant to Ontario Regulation 525/97, made under the Planning Act, applications for amendment to the Official Plan for The Regional Municipality of York commenced on or after January 19, 1998, are exempt from the approval of the Minister of Municipal Affairs and Housing. Once notice of decision is given, if you have objections to this amendment you may file with the Clerk of The Regional Municipality of York, within the time specified in the notice of decision, a notice of appeal to the Ontario Municipal Board.

NOTE:

1. If a person or public body does not make oral submissions at the public meeting or make written submissions to York Region before the proposed official plan amendment is adopted, the person or public body is not entitled to appeal the decisions of York Region Council to the Ontario Municipal Board.

If a person or public body does not make oral submissions at the public meeting or make written submissions to York Region before the proposed official plan amendment is adopted, the person or public body may not be added as a party to the hearing of an appeal before the Ontario Municipal Board unless, in the opinion of the Board, there are reasonable grounds to add the person or public body as a party.

2. If you wish to be notified of the adoption of the proposed Official Plan Amendment, or the refusal of a request to amend the official plan, you must make a written request to the Clerk of The Regional Municipality of York in care of the address at the end of this notice.

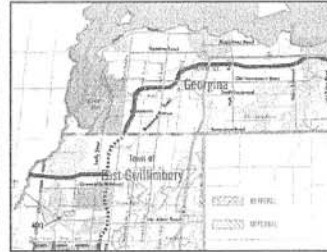

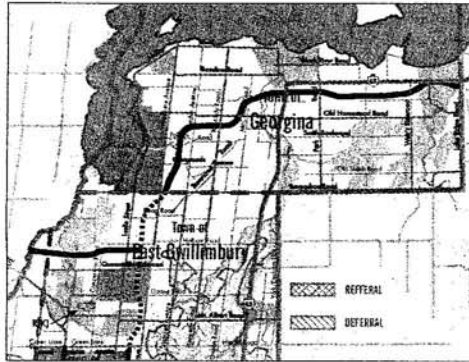

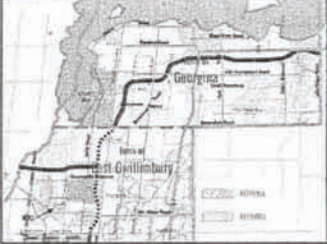
