For your information and records, at its regular meeting held on August 9, 2010, the Municipal Council of the Town of East Gwillimbury enacted as follows:

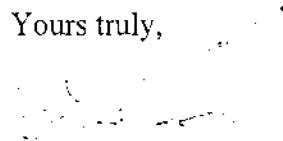
