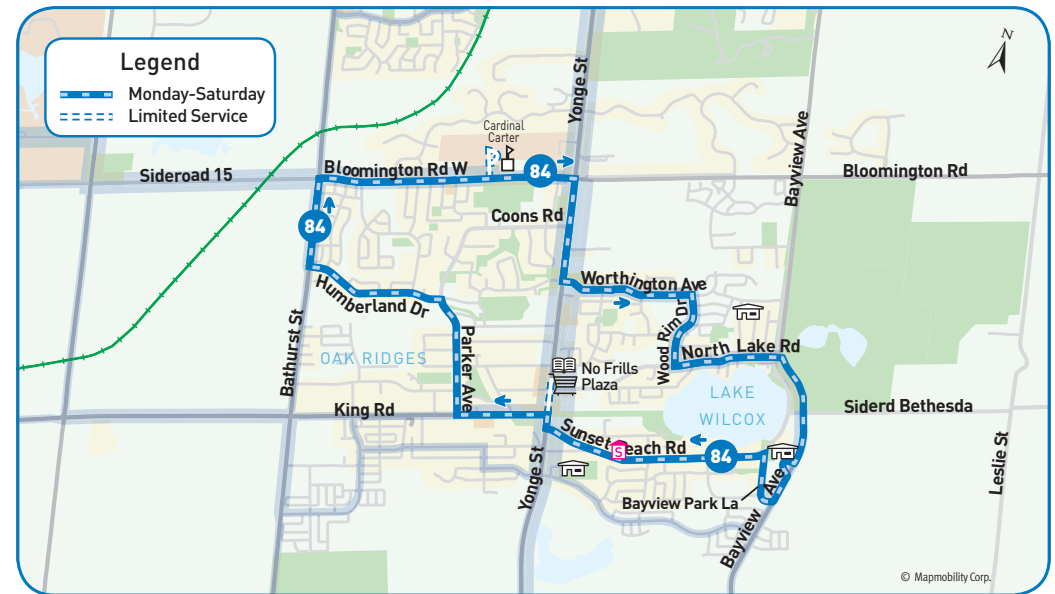

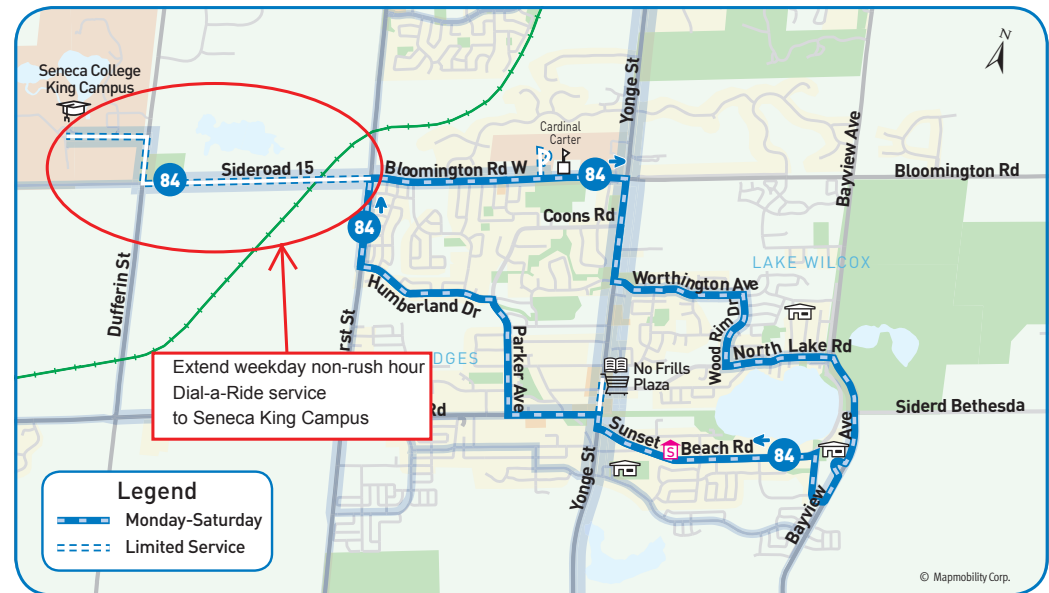

Proposed Service Changes:

- > Reduce rush hour service frequency due to low ridership
- > Extend Dial-a-Ride Service to Seneca College King Campus during weekday midday, and evening

Passenger Impacts/Options:

- > Seven passengers per hour will be impacted as a result of decreased frequency on the conventional Route 84 service
- > Two passengers per hour as a result of decreased frequency on the Dial-a-Ride service

- > Rush-hour frequency will be adjusted from 17 minutes to 34 minutes
- > Trips will meet bell time at Cardinal Carter High School
- > Provides Seneca College students with a weekday midday and evening option to connect to the Dial-a-Ride services on Yonge Street
- > Dial-a-Ride weekday midday and evening frequency will be adjusted from 40 to 50 minutes
