**RE: RETAIL BUSINESS HOLIDAYS ACT - REMAINING OPEN ON HOLIDAYS IN 2003
(C10-CL & L11)**

Please be advised that the above-noted matter was placed before Council at its meeting held on June 23rd, 2003.

It was the decision of the Council, at that time, to pass the following resolution:

"THAT the Town of Whitchurch-Stouffville requests the exemption of all retail businesses within the geographic boundaries of the Town of Whitchurch-Stouffville from the provisions of the Retail Business Holidays Act, pursuant to Section 5 of Regulation 711/91, due to the special event surrounding the Severe Acute Respiratory Syndrome (SARS) epidemic, for the following three statutory holidays: Labour Day, Thanksgiving and Christmas Day during 2003, thereby allowing retail businesses to operate and encouraging increased economic activity."

Amendment

"THAT the minutes of the Council meeting dated June 23, 2003 be amended for Item 2, *Retail Business Holidays Act - Remaining Open on Holidays in 2003*, to delete Christmas Day."
